

Do's & Don'ts For Container Use

Do:

- ✓ Place the container according to this brochure.
- ✓ Keep the lid completely closed.
- ✓ **Bag all garbage** before placing in container.
- ✓ If you are moving, the container is to remain with the residence.
- ✓ Please recycle.

Don't:

- Ø Put hot ashes in the container.
- Ø Overfill the container.
- Ø Pack garbage in container too tightly
- Ø Paint or write on container.
- Ø **No tin, steel or propane tanks.**
- Ø Remove container from residence.
- Ø Put cut or bagged grass and garden debris in container.

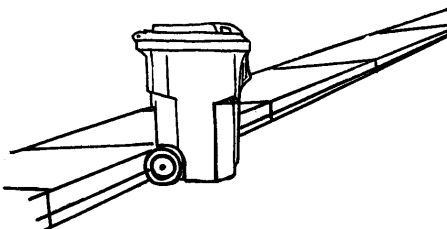
--Any repairs needed as a result of damage, vandalism or theft must be reported to the Town and the homeowner will be responsible for the costs.

--The Town of Battleford reserves the right to leave any container that is not in compliance with the rules set out in this brochure.

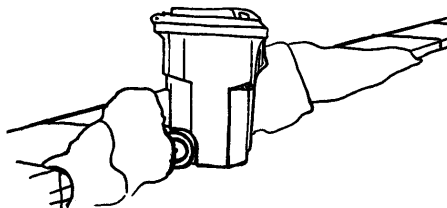
--Please note our garbage truck is equipped with a camera and we are aware of what goes into the hopper from each container.

Ideal Location #1

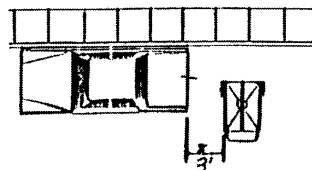


Snow Bank #2

Dear Battleford Resident,

The Town of Battleford is proud to supply you with this fine 5 US gallon container.

Please take a few moments to familiarize your self with these easy to remember instructions regarding the automated refuse collection system. This system uses the latest collection equipment available and provides maximum efficiency at minimum expense. We want to do the best possible job for you and would appreciate your cooperation.

The Town of Battleford also encourages you to participate in recycling by taking advantage of our recycle depot, located at 411-27th Street West behind the AG Canada Building. We strongly encourage residents to look at composting to dispose of garden and grass debris. Remember recycling is everyone's business.

Town of Battleford Refuse Schedule – pickup

Monday	Green Compost Containers
Tuesday	15 th –19 th St W & E, Regional Care Road, Battle Springs, West Park
Wednesday	20 th –29 th W & E, Battleford West, 1 st Ave W
Thursday	30 th St W and Everything North
Friday	Overload

* If a statutory holiday falls during the week, garbage pickup will move one day later.

WASTE COLLECTIONS

--Always have the wheels of the container facing toward the curb. When there is a snow bank built up along the curb, make sure the container is out further than the snow bank.

--We ask that you refrain from parking on the street on collection day, however, if there are vehicles on the street, please make sure to place the container further out than the vehicle. Please see the back of this brochure for can placement instructions.

If your house is on a street or avenue without a curb, please place the container on the road making sure the garbage truck can reach the container. The container must be placed on the street or avenue which corresponds with your address.

--To avoid having your container missed, please have your container out by 7:00 am on collection day.

--For your child's safety, do not allow them to play near the collection containers or vehicle.

General Guidelines on How to Use Your Container

--All garbage must be bagged.

--The black container lid must be **completely closed** to ensure pickup. You must be able to close the lid without packing garbage in the container too tightly; otherwise the garbage may not slide out.

--Place the container on the street on your scheduled pickup day.

--Remove container from the street as soon as possible after pickup.

--Do not remove the container from its assigned address.

--Inform the Town of Battleford of any damage, vandalism or theft of the container. It is important to note the serial number stamped on the cart placed at your residence.

Following these instructions will assist us in making the Town of Battleford one of the cleanest Towns in Saskatchewan.

Thank you for your cooperation in making this cleaner and more efficient waste collection system work for you.
