## Materials Allowed in Your GREEN COMPOST CONTAINER:

- --Kitchen scraps: egg shells,fruit & vegetable wtes,coffee grounds, tea bags, etc
- --Yard wastes: leaves, grass clippings, garden plants, flowers, etc
- -- Dog fur & Human hair
- -- Dryer lint
- --Shredded newspaper (NOT colored)
- -- "Cold" wood ashes only NOT charcoal or coal ashes

All materials must be loose in compost recycling containers.

#### **PLEASE DO NOT BAG**

The Town of Battleford's garbage truck is equipped with a camera.

# Materials NOT Allowed in Your Green Compost Container

- --Meat scraps, bones, fish & poultry
- --Oily or fatty foods
- --Herbicide contaminated grass clippings or plants
- -- Cat & Dog Manure
- -- Diseased Plants
- -- Colored Newspaper
- --Tree Branches
- -- Cardboard
- --Plastic/Bags etc
- \*\*\*\*These ARE contaminants



#### Rules to follow by

- --The compost container is to be placed the same way as your refuse container (wheels to curb)
- --Lid MUST be closed
- --Please don't pack materials in your containers, as they may not slide out.
- --Compost is picked up on **Mondays**.
- -- Compost containers should be placed by **7:00 a.m.**

#### Contamination

--It is imperative that you **DO NOT** taint the compost in your
Green Compost Container.
