

THE GREEN BIN PROGRAM IS AN OPTIONAL SERVICE.

Residents must purchase a green bin to participate in this program. Green bins will be sold at (\$110.00 + GST) and can be purchased at Town Hall. Each household is allowed maximum of two green bins.

PRICE IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE

Delivery of bins are on Friday's

Residents are encouraged to purchase compost containers to help divert compost material from the waste stream and reduce costs.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE OF BINS:

The care and upkeep of the green compost bin is the responsibility of the property owner.

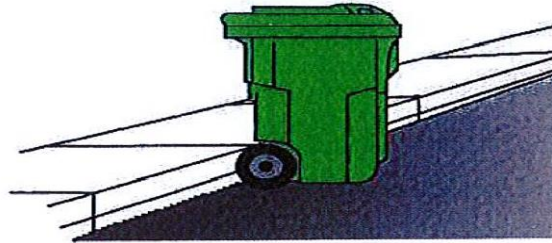
All maintenance and repair work completed is to be charged the cost of the replacement part and a flat labour to the property owner.

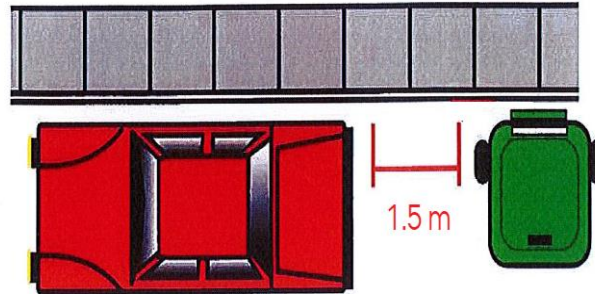


Required Location:

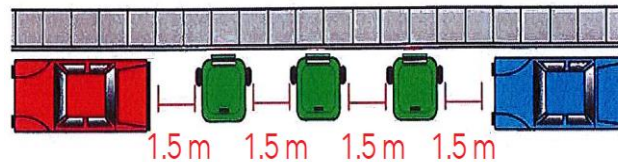


Curbside

COMPOSTING CONTAINERS



COLLECTION DAY LEGEND

MONDAY COMPOST (APRIL-NOVEMBER)

If a statutory holiday falls on a Monday from April to November the compost pick-up day will move to Tuesday.

Compost material being accumulated and stored for the purpose of being collected shall be:

- **Deposited loosely into the compost container**
- Free of contaminants including, but limited to, household waste, plastic, trees, etc.

Following these instructions will assist us in making the Town of Battleford one of the cleanest Towns in Saskatchewan.

ITEMS ACCEPTED:

- Fallen Leaves
- Grass clippings
- Garden refuse (e.g. plant tops and clippings, flowers, stalks, fallen fruit)
- Twigs (smaller than your finger in diameter, and no longer than an arm's length)
- Weeds
- Wood chips and bark mulch
- Pine and spruce cones and needles
- Household plants, including soil
- Fruits and vegetables (cooked or raw, including peels and pits)
- Nuts, seeds
- Eggs, eggshells
- Coffee grounds & tea bags
- Herbs and spices
- Dog and human hair
- Dryer lint

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:

- Any bagged material
- Plastic, of any type
- Packaging and wrappers, of all types
- Dairy products, including milk, yogurt and cheese
- Fats, cooking oils, and grease
- Salad dressing, mayonnaise, gravy, and sauces
- Meat, seafood, poultry scraps and bones
- Butcher's meat wrap, waxed- and plastic-coated paper
- Chips, candy, baked goods
- Mixed table scraps
- Liquids
- Beverage containers
- Pet waste, pet food, animal bedding, animal carcasses
- Cigarette butts, tobacco, ashes, fireplace and BBQ ashes, matches
- Corks (from wine bottles, etc.)
- Q-tips, cotton balls, cosmetics, make-up removal pads, dental floss
- Diapers, baby wipes, feminine hygiene products
- Medicines and pharmaceuticals
- Styrofoam
- Clothing, textiles, rope, rags
- Floor sweepings, vacuum bags, vacuum contents
- Glass, Metal
- Rocks
- Drywall

It is imperative that you DO NOT taint the compost in your Green Compost Container.

GENERAL DUTIES:

1. Place Green Container roadside by 7 am
2. Return the emptied container to your property before the end of the day
3. It is important to note the serial number stamped on the cart at the time of delivery at your residence.
4. Lid **MUST** be closed to ensure pickup

Always have the wheels of the container facing toward the curb.

Please refrain from parking on the street on collection day, however, if there are vehicles on the street, please make sure to place the container 1.5 m from vehicles. Please see the back of this brochure for can placement instructions.

Please note that the Town of Battleford garbage truck is equipped with a camera.

For your child's safety, do not allow them to play near the containers or vehicle on collection day.

Thank you for your cooperation in making this cleaner and more efficient composting system work for you.

Any household who contravenes any provisions set out in this brochure will be subject to a fine according to the:
