



This Notice is in accordance with:

**Bylaw 1/2017 – Waste Management Public Utility & Policy /017 – Maintenance, Repair and Replacement of Solid Waste Containers**

**DEFINITION:**

2 (h) Household Waste – includes such materials produced by residents of a municipality such as food scraps, packing, and general household waste that cannot be recycled.

**WASTE MANAGEMENT:**

- 14) The municipality reserves the right to refuse to collect for removal any of the following waste:
- a) Any receptacle that is not an approved container as designated by the municipality as required by section 5
  - b) Any receptacle or waste item that is considered oversized or overweight or a container that has an open lid
  - c) Branches, grass, and trees
  - d) Hazardous waste
  - e) Any waste material or item not accepted at the Waste Disposal Site
  - f) Any other waste material or item that could be considered unsuitable for collection
  - g) Improper positioning of the container. All containers must be 1.5 meters from vehicles, objects, and other containers

**ESTABLISHING THE RATES FOR THE DISPOSAL OF REFUSE:**

- 20) The levy imposed by Schedule "A", shall be billed with the quarterly utility billing.  
21) The whole or any part of the levy payable pursuant to Section 19, that remains unpaid on December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year in which the levy became payable, is to be added to and thereby forms part of the taxes on the land and buildings in respect of which of which the disposal is done.

**GENERAL DUTIES:**

1. All items MUST be bagged
2. Place bin roadside by 7:00 a.m. on collection day
3. Return the emptied cart to your property before the end of the day
4. Do NOT remove the cart from its assigned address
5. Inform the Public Works Department of any damages, vandalism, or theft of the bin
6. Lid MUST be closed

**MAINTENANCE AND CARE OF BINS:**

- The care and upkeep of the solid waste containers is the responsibility of the property owner.
- Damaged solid waste containers are to be reported to the Public Works Department for maintenance and repair.
- All maintenance and repair work completed is to be charged the cost of the replacement part and a flat labour rate of \$30 plus taxes to the property owner.
- The Town will supply a new solid waste container to newly constructed homes. If there is a change of property owner, that property owner will continue to use the solid waste container designated for that civic address
- New solid waste containers will be sold at cost (\$96.09 Tax Included +\$30.00 administration fee).
