WASTE MANAGEMENT:

Household Waste – includes materials such as food scraps, packaging, and general household waste that cannot be recycled.

The municipality reserves the right to refuse the collection of any of the following waste:

- a) Any bin that is not an approved container as designated by the municipality
- Any bin or waste item that is considered oversized or overweight
- c) Any bin that has an open lid
- d) Branches, grass, and trees
- e) Hazardous waste
- f) Any waste material or item not accepted at the Waste Disposal Site
- g) Improper positioning of the container. All containers must be 1.5 meters from vehicles, objects, and other containers, wheels against curb

Delivery of bins are on Friday's

MAINTENANCE AND CARE OF BINS:

The care and upkeep of the solid waste containers is the responsibility of the property owner.

Damaged solid waste containers are to be reported to the Public Works Department for maintenance and repair.


If the container cannot be repaired then a new solid waste container will be sold at cost.

All maintenance and repair work completed is to be charged the cost of the replacement part and a flat labour rate plus taxes to the property owner.


Maximum 1 waste container per household new/existing. The bins remain on the property should ownership change.


REQUIRED LOCATION

Please take a few moments to familiarize yourself with these easy to remember instructions regarding the automated refuse collection system.

This system uses the latest collection equipment available and provides maximum efficiency at minimum expense. We want to do the best possible job for you and would appreciate your cooperation.

In 2016 the Town of Battleford contracted Loraas to collect single stream recycling from your home. Any questions regarding recycling please contact Loraas at 306-445-3900. Schedules are available on the Town of Battleford Website and at Town Hall.

REFUSE SCHEDULE PICKUP:

If a statutory holiday falls on a Monday from April – November your garbage pickup will move one day later. December – March pickups will not be affected except for Christmas and New Year's.

Refuse Calendars are available at Town Hall, Works Department, and on the Town of Battleford website.

WASTE COLLECTIONS:

Always have the wheels of the container facing toward the curb. When there is a snow bank built up along the curb, make sure the container is out further than the snow bank.

Please refrain from parking on the street on collection day, however, if there are vehicles on the street, please make sure to place the container 1.5 m away from vehicles. Please see the back of this brochure for can placement instructions.

If your house is situated on a graveled street or avenue, please place the container at the edge of the roadway to ensure the garbage truck can reach it.

For your child's safety, do not allow them to play near the containers or vehicle on collection day.

GENERAL DUTIES:

- 1. All items MUST be bagged
- 2. Place bin roadside by 7:00 a.m. on collection day
- 3. Return the emptied cart to your property before the end of the day
- Do NOT remove the cart from its assigned address. It is important to note the serial number stamped on the cart placed at your residence.
- 5. Inform the Public Works Department of any damages, vandalism, or theft of the bin
- 6. Lid MUST be closed to ensure pickup

Please note that the Town of Battleford garbage truck is equipped with a camera.

Following these instructions will assist us in making the Town of Battleford one of the cleanest Towns in Saskatchewan.

Thank you for your cooperation in making this cleaner and more efficient waste collection system work for you.
