Position Overview

We are seeking a certified Utilities Water and Sewer Operator Level 1 to assist with the operation and maintenance of water and sewer facilities. This role involves ensuring the efficient, safe, and effective operation of water plants, sewer lifts, and related equipment. The position requires adherence to safety, quality, and company standards.

The position is open to all qualified applicants and is covered by the Canadian Union of Public Employees (CUPE) Local 3003 Collective Agreement.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Operate and maintain water and sewer facilities, including water plants, wells, and sewage lagoons.
- Maintain equipment such as trucks, jettors, and power tools.
- Assist with water treatment, distribution, metering, and sewage collection.
- Achieve required certifications (WHMIS, First Aid & CPR, H2S, Confined Space, etc.) within the first year.
- Complete timesheets, daily logs, and ensure safety regulations are followed.
- Work evening and weekend shifts, as required.
- Assist in training and orienting other staff.
- Perform additional duties as directed by the Utilities Manager.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Saskatchewan certification in:
 - Water Treatment I, Water Distribution I, Wastewater Collection I, and Wastewater Treatment I.
- Grade 12 education or equivalent.
- Valid Saskatchewan Class 5 Driver's License.
- Experience in utility operations and maintenance.
- Ability to work independently and effectively communicate.
- Willingness to work shifts, overtime, and be on-call.
- Good physical condition and ability to perform manual labor.
- Ability to work safely in confined spaces and sewage-related tasks.

Desired Experience and Training:

- Related experience in plumbing, electrical, or mechanical fields.
- Certifications in WHMIS, First Aid & CPR, OH&S Levels I & II, H2S, Ground Disturbance, and Confined Space Level I & II.
