

Placing Your Bin

- Bins should be placed on the street with the wheels touching the curb
- Homeowners are responsible for placing bins past the boulevard or snow windrow
- Bins cannot block alley access

Your Bins

If your bin is not at curbside for collection, you must store your bin on your property.

All items **MUST** be bagged

Lid **MUST** be closed


If you've got shredded paper for recycling, put it into a clear bag and tie it securely.

You are responsible for making sure your bin gets on the street for your curbside collection. Bins must be out before 7am on the day of your collection.

Do not remove the container from its assigned address.

It is not recommended that you put your bins out for collection the night before.

Please do not mark or paint anything on the bins.

The Town of Battleford supplies residents with one 95 US gallon refuse bin.

Please take a few moments to familiarize yourself with these easy to remember instructions regarding the automated refuse collection system.

This system uses the latest collection equipment available and provides maximum efficiency at minimum expense.

Please note: The Town of Battleford garbage truck is equipped with a camera.

Pickup Schedule

The Town of Battleford implements Bi-Weekly pickup in the Winter months and weekly pick up in the summer months.

Winter bi-weekly pickup will commence the 1st week of November to the last week of April.

Summer weekly pickup will commence the 1st week of May to the last week of October.

Schedules are available on the Town website, Town Hall Office and the Public Works Shop.

Additional Bins:

Additional garbage bin can be purchased by calling Town Hall at (306) 937-6220.

Additional bins are charged per quarterly utility billing per bin.

Price is subject to change without prior notice

Missing Bins:

Each bin is marked with a serial number. Please record that number and keep it in a safe accessible place.

If you are unable to find or recover your bin, you can request a replacement by calling Town Hall at (306) 937-6220.

Please Note: Replacement Bins are available for purchase however, if you find your original bin, the fee will be refunded to you.

Delivery of bins are on Friday's.

Maintenance and Care of Bins:

The care and upkeep of the bins is the responsibility of the property owners.

Damaged bins are to be reported to the Public Works Department for maintenance and repair.

Any damaged, lost, or vandalized bins will be replaced at the homeowner's cost.

Any household that contravenes any provisions set out in this brochure can be will subject to a fine according to the Waste Management Public Utility Bylaw and Maintenance Repair and Replacement of Solid Waste Containers Policy

Thank you for your cooperation in making this cleaner and more efficient waste collection system work for you.

Prohibited Items:

The Town of Battleford accepts only solid, non-hazardous waste materials including general garbage. We do **not accept** regulated waste such as:

- Hazardous Waste
- Medical Waste
- Pressure Filled Containers
- Paint
- Used Oil or Containers
- Electronics

Other items unsuitable for the bin(s):

- Sod, dirt, and tree clippings
- Ashes of any kind
- Construction or demolition materials including concrete, boards, roofing materials, carpet, etc.
- Automotive parts, oil filters, batteries, tires, etc.

- Liquids of any kind
- Animals or animal parts

Bin Collection Refusal:

Bins will not be collected for the following reasons:

- if the bin is damaged
- if the bin is facing the wrong direction
- if the bins lid is not completely closed
- if there is not enough space between the bin and surrounding objects. All bins must be 1.5 meters from all objects.
- if the bin contains unacceptable materials for garbage
- if the bin is not out at the scheduled date and time
- if the bin is not a Town bin assigned to the property.
